The proposed solar energy development has remained a key topic throughout the year. The Community Council has worked hard to ensure that residents' views are heard, maintaining open dialogue with the project team and consistently representing local concerns at meetings. While discussions are ongoing, we remain committed to advocating for the best interests of our community.

As we look ahead, the Council will continue to focus on delivering practical improvements, supporting community initiatives, and ensuring that the voices of residents remain at the heart of everything we do.
